How to Teach Them Today

 AI-Enhanced Communication → Assign students to draft a message using AI, then refine it manually using the Three-Step Writing Process (planning, composing, completing).

 Critical Prompting & Editing → Run a “prompt lab” where students experiment with different AI prompts and critique which ones yield the best business results.

 Digital Storytelling → Have students turn a dense report into a LinkedIn carousel, infographic, or short video script.

 Ethical Decision-Making → Present an AI-generated case study with bias or misinformation embedded—then ask students to spot the risks and propose fixes.

 Agility & Continuous Learning → Build in short “emerging tool demos” (e.g., AI transcription, AI slide design) and ask students to reflect on how they might use them in internships or first jobs.
